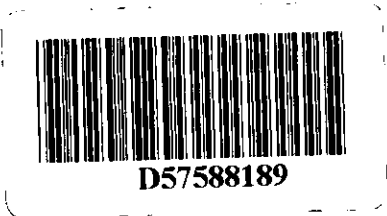

Plaintiffs filed a motion for default judgment against Defendant Aaron Booher. This Court granted the motion and set a hearing to determine damages. On September 8, 2003 Plaintiffs Rachel Meyers, Beverly Meyers, and Gregory Meyers testified and were cross examined by Mr. Booher's counsel. Mr. Booher was properly subpoenaed to the hearing but failed to appear. Counsel presented closing arguments to the Court on October 3, 2003. Having considered all the evidence presented, this Court grants a judgment to Plaintiffs against Aaron Booher on all claims as follows:

To Rachel Meyers, a judgment of \$10,000 for compensatory damages.

To Beverly and Gregory Meyers jointly, a judgment of \$20,000.00 in compensatory damages, a judgment of \$1,883.00 in special damages for reimbursement of the cost of hiring a private investigator; \$40,000.00 in punitive damages.


To all plaintiffs jointly, \$20,000 in payment of reasonable attorney fees.




The Court hereby enters judgment of \$91,883.00 against Defendant Aaron Boohar. All Court Costs shall be assessed against Aaron Boohar.
